OVERVIEW

The data establishes that IHCC significantly expanded and intensified its work in response to the COVID-19 economic crisis.

The challenges that Latino businesses are facing in 2020 required IHCC to increase its efforts, adapt to rapidly changing circumstances and refine its approach. IHCC focused on a prompt, consistent response that includes ongoing measures of the impact of its work. The economic crisis caused by the pandemic called for a best effort from IHCC, for work beyond the conventional. IHCC has made great strides in its efforts and continues to be strictly focused on adapting to meet emerging challenges.

OVERVIEW

IHCC's assistance to small businesses to access financial resources increased by 315% from 2019 and totals \$88.1M. This is the total dollar amount of contracts awarded; revenue growth, business loans from the Small Business Administration, private lenders, business grants, and others.

The number of jobs created and retained increased 42 times compared to 2019. This increment is mainly because of IHCC's rapid response throughout its programs: Illinois SBDC, PTAC, SBTRC, Illinois Tollway Technical Assistance Program, the Cook County COVID-19: Small Business Assistance Program, and the team's professionalism always willing to help.

The IHCC team delivered thousands of hours of actual contact with thousands of business owners and entrepreneurs including telephone calls and video-conference counseling sessions. Contact time is captured through customer relationship management software and unique time-tracking systems.


